This is an academic training program tailored for post-graduates in Otolaryngology and General surgery with special interest in head and neck cancer care. This fellowship is accredited by Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences, Telangana.

This fellowship intends to train the fellows with all the aspects of patient care in this population including diagnosis, treatment planning, ablative and reconstructive surgery and post-operative management.

Clinical research will be an essential component. The aim will be developing concise and focused thinking in a structured training environment.

Clinical Responsibilities

The Head and Neck Fellow will:

- Participate in all head and neck operative cases including microvascular reconstruction.
- Participate in Multidisciplinary Oncology Clinic
- To attend the Outpatient clinic
- Participate in day to day activities in the unit including managing emergencies.

Surgical training includes:

- Ablative surgeries of head and neck oncology.
- Reconstructive experience including local, regional, and free tissue transfer for defects of the head and neck region.
- Transoral robotic and laser surgery for head and neck malignancies including oropharyngeal, tongue and larynx.
- Anterior and lateral skull base surgery
- Endocrine experience including management of thyroid and parathyroid malignancies.
- Management of advanced benign lesions of the head and neck including salivary gland tumours, schwannoma, paraganglioma, etc.
- Comprehensive surgical management of the head and neck oncology patient including ancillary procedures such as airway reconstruction, voice restoration, and facial nerve reanimation.

Rotations

Fellows will be posted in allied specialties.

Eligibility - Should have completed M.S./ DNB in Otolaryngology/General surgery with permanent registration in Medical council. Age < 45 yrs.

Foreign medical graduates shall submit a) equivalent certificate issued by MCI, New Delhi, b) Registration certificate from Medical council of India.

Number of Seats: Two seats, with one candidate -sponsored candidate from Govt of Telangana.

Note - All fellowship courses in this institution are full-time in-service training programmes and medical practice or any other employment outside the Institution is **strictly not permitted**.

Mode of selection -

Selection will be purely on the Merit basis. MS/DNB exam marks(50%) and the Marks in the Interview(50%) conducted by expert panel for the selection of the candidates will be considered for the selection as per university guidelines.

The fellow will be required to maintain the surgical case log with a comprehensive list of all cases participated in. Submission of the completed operative case log will be an essential requirement for issuance of the fellowship completion certificate.

Six monthly assessment examination will be conducted.

Fellow is expected to present two presentation in national/ international conferences and should be author in the two original research publications.

Exit examination will be conducted which will include theory and viva voce with minimum passing requirement of 50% marks and candidate required to pass the exam for fellowship completion certificate.
